

COMMUNITY RESPONSE TEAM (CRT)

Provides 24/7 support to adults who are experiencing emotional, psychiatric or substance use vulnerabilities, including on-the-spot assessment and referral to behavioral health care. Serves youth on the weekend.

SUICIDE & CRISIS HOTLINE

Provides assistance to anyone experiencing suicidal, substance use, mental health crisis, and/or emotional distress.

THE ASSESSMENT AND REFERRAL CENTER (SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT)
